This Cookies Policy explains what Cookies are and how We use them. You should read this policy so You can understand what type of cookies We use, or the information We collect using Cookies and how that information is used.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Cookies Policy:

- **Company** (referred to as either "The Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Cookies Policy) refers to Bitazza Company Limited.
- **Cookies** means small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing details of your browsing history on that website among its many uses.
- **Website** refers to Bitazza, accessible from <https://bitazza.com>
- **You** mean the individual accessing or using the Website, or a company, or any legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Website, as applicable.

What are cookies?

Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal information that we store about You may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from Cookies. Why do we use cookies?

We use our cookies and third party cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for our Websites to operate, and we refer to these as "necessary" or "essential" cookies. Other cookies also enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our Websites. Third party serve cookies through our Websites for advertising, analytics and other purposes. This is described in more detail below.

Type of Cookies We Use

Cookies can be "Persistent" or "Session" Cookies. Persistent Cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when You go offline, while Session Cookies are deleted as soon as You close your web browser.

We use both session and persistent Cookies for the purposes set out below:

- **Necessary / Essential Cookies**

Type: Session Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide You with services available through the Website and to enable You to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these Cookies, the services that You have asked for cannot be provided, and We only use these Cookies to provide You with those services.

- **Performance /Analytics Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Purpose : These Cookies allow Us to count visits and traffic sources so We can measure and improve the performance of Our Websites. They help Us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around Websites. All information these Cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous.

- **Functionality Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies allow us to remember choices You make when You use the Website, such as remembering your login details or language preference. The purpose of these Cookies is to provide You with a more personal experience and to avoid You having to re-enter your preferences every time You use the Website.

- **Targeting/Advertising Cookies**

Type: Persistent Cookies

Purposes: These cookies are used to make advertising messages more relevant to you. They perform functions like preventing the same ad from continuously reappearing, ensuring that ads are properly displayed for advertisers, and in some cases selecting advertisements that are based on your interests.
